### Letters from your HOA

After receiving feedback from our Facebook survey last spring, we were made aware that more people would like us to educate neighbors who may not understand the responsibilities a deed restricted neighborhood requires. We are committed to making sure our neighborhood properties maintain both the curb appeal that drew most of us to the neighborhood when considering purchasing our homes and the safety and well-being of our neighbors. Letters were sent to over 50 neighbors asking them to move trailers & cars, check their fences, confirm their accessory buildings, and other items to help Chelsea Woods stay true to the developer's premier neighborhood vision. Thank you to everyone who took the time to bring their properties back in to compliance with city codes and our Deed Restrictions.

#### **Parking Refresher**

There have been many questions about parking on Seneca Boulevard and other streets in our neighborhood. While Seneca has a solid white line on both sides which normally indicates no parking is allowed, the City of Winter Springs has determined otherwise. While parking, here are some things to keep in mind:

- Park only in the same direction as traffic (right wheels to the curb)
- Park on the pavement, NOT on the grass
- If possible, leave the gutter section (the concrete ribbon beside the asphalt) clear for water runoff
- Do not park opposite another parked car on the street, if possible, try to only have parked cars on one side of the street
- Do not park within 30 feet of a curve exceeding 90 degrees
- Do not park within 20 feet of an intersection
- Do not park within 15 feet of a fire hydrant or within 3 feet of a city utility meter
- Do not park more that 12 inches from the grass

#### Trash & Recycle News



Waste Pro is our local provider but did you know you could request a smaller rolling waste bin by calling 407-774-0800? They just need your street address to arrange an exchange. The standard/larger bins are 95 gallon and the smaller still hold 64 gallon with a smaller footprint. Having a smaller bin may help you find a better place to hide it when not at the curb. Let's try to improve the look of our neighborhood with this small adjustment. Our Deed Restrictions state:

No lot shall be used or maintained as a dumping ground for rubbish, trash or other waste. All trash, garbage and other waste shall be kept in sanitary containers and, except during pick-up, if required to be placed at the curb, all containers shall be kept at the rear of all dwellings out of sight from the street. There shall be no burning of the trash or any other waste materials.



Have your recycle bins seen better days? You can take them to the Utility Department at Winter Springs City Hall for a replacement (if it is a City of Winter Springs bin). If you need an extra bin, they are available for \$6.00. More questions can be answered by calling them directly at 407-327-5996.




# Calling All Ghosts, Goblins, Witches and More!
