What does the HOA Do?

This topic comes up quite a bit so we thought we'd share a little more about the Chelsea Woods HOA. We are self run, with no management company. That means every dollar received goes into the community. All of the board members are volunteers. Your dues pay for things such as: The north entrance pond fountain and lighting. Lighting, watering, and upkeep of both entrances, utility fees, insurance, website hosting, and state fees. A breakdown of these fees are presented at the annual meeting for all to see.

We are happy to report that we can once again keep dues to a minimal \$60/year this year, the same rate it has been for almost 2 decades.

HOA Reminders



We know that many of us had guests (invited or otherwise) this Holiday season. As a reminder for those that had house guests that may have been traveling via RV. All RV's, Trailers, Campers, etc. Must be stored either offsite or as described in article 20 of the HOA Deed Restrictions.

Recreational vehicles, to include campers, boats, motor homes, shall be kept in the rear or side of the house and shall be adequately screened from view from all adjacent properties, as well as from the street fronting said property

We would also like to take the time to thank those residents that have reconstructed their screening fences and continued the cleanup from Irma.
